Selebe Yoon, Dakar

Selebe Yoon – meaning ‘intersection’ in Wolof – opened its new gallery in central Dakar last November with a display of works by Senegalese artist Alioune Diouf (b. 1964). As well as recent paintings on fabric (Fig. 3), the show includes a large-scale site-specific commission that combines textiles and figurative murals; terracotta-hued, but incorporating cosmic symbols, they continue Diouf’s exploration of the gaps between the earthly and the spiritual.
